

Golf Course Greenskeeper

The golf course greenskeeper reports directly to the golf course superintendent. Under the superintendent's supervision, greenskeepers participate in the daily maintenance of the golf course tees, greens, fairways, sand traps, landscape, and cart paths.

Essential Functions of the Job:

- General knowledge and capability to operate various types of equipment, including but not limited to walk behind mowers, triplex mowers, large area reel and rotary style mowers, blowers, sprayers, and hand-held tools and equipment.
- Knowledge of safe, efficient mechanical operation of tractors and other motorized equipment.
- Ensures that the equipment cooling system is always working; refills fuel and oil daily; cleans equipment daily; and reports equipment problems or failures to Equipment Manager immediately.
- Provides basic preventive maintenance on equipment as directed by the equipment manager or assistant superintendent and returns equipment to the designated location at the maintenance facility.
- Help keep entire golf property attractive, neat, and clean free of trash and waste.
- Helps to maintains a clean and safe work environment.
- All other reasonable assignments given by management.

Requirements:

- Practical knowledge of the rules and strategies of the game of golf.
- Mechanical aptitude.
- Ability to follow oral and written directions.
- Valid Driver's License preferred.
- Position will be required to work a varied schedule that may include evenings, nights, and weekends. Reliable and predictable attendance is required.
- Meet or exceed all essential functions of the job, including but not limited to, work performance goals

Physical Demands:

- Must be able to frequently sit, stand, bend, use hands to finger, handle, or feel; and talk or hear, stoop, kneel, crouch, crawl, and walk.
- Ability to lift 50 lbs., and to lift overhead and push/pull, move lighter objects.

Work environment:

- Generally, works in an outdoors environment. The employee is regularly exposed to wet and/or humid conditions, outside weather conditions, extreme cold, and extreme heat.
- The employee is occasionally exposed to moving mechanical parts; high, precarious places; fumes or airborne particles; toxic or caustic chemicals; risk of electrical shock; and vibration.
- The noise level is moderate for most of the workday and/or essential functions. A portion of workdays and/or essential functions may result in high noise level.
